(*Buxus sempervirens*)

6' tall x 6' spread

2' tall x 2' spread

A very slow-growing dwarf form that's been used formally for centuries. Very dense. Great for small spot

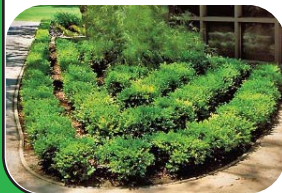


### 'Green Beauty'

A priceless gem described as a perfect round ball of glossy dark green foliage. Excellent winter color retention. Stays dense with no pruning. Super hardy.

6' tall x 3' spread  
Distinctly upright & conical with a broad base. Green year-round. Cold hardy to -30F.



### 'Green Velvet'

(*Buxus* x 'Green Velvet')

2-3' tall x 2-3' spread

This low-mounding variety that boasts luxuriant deep green, pointy leaves. Tremendously cold hardy & compact.

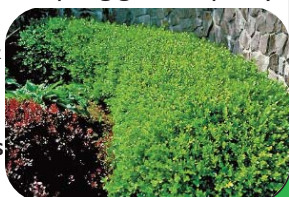


### 'Winter Gem'

- prefer **partial shade** & a fertile soil.
- have shallow roots, so should be **mulched well** & watered if soil dries.

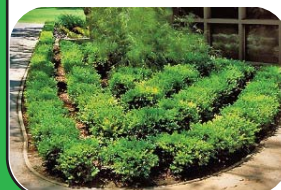

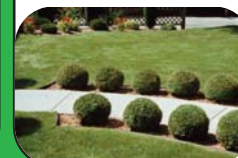

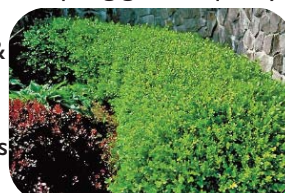
