Except as stated in the sentence immediately above, Millane Nurseries makes no warranty of any kind, either expressed or implied and specifically, Millane Nurseries makes NO IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSE and all plant material sold hereunder is SOLD AS IS. WE SHALL IN NO CASE BE LIABLE FOR ANY SUM GREATER THAN THE ORIGINAL VALUE FOR SAID STOCK.

CLAIMS: Any and all claims that the nursery stock sold is not true to name, and/or claims of shipping damage(s), shortage(s), and/or discrepancy of product quality, must be made on the Bill of Lading and signed by the customer or their bona fide representative; but in any case, all claim(s) must also be made in writing and include or be supplemented by ample and discernable dated photographic evidence and documentation supporting said claim(s) within five (5) days of the delivery/pick-up date of said product.
