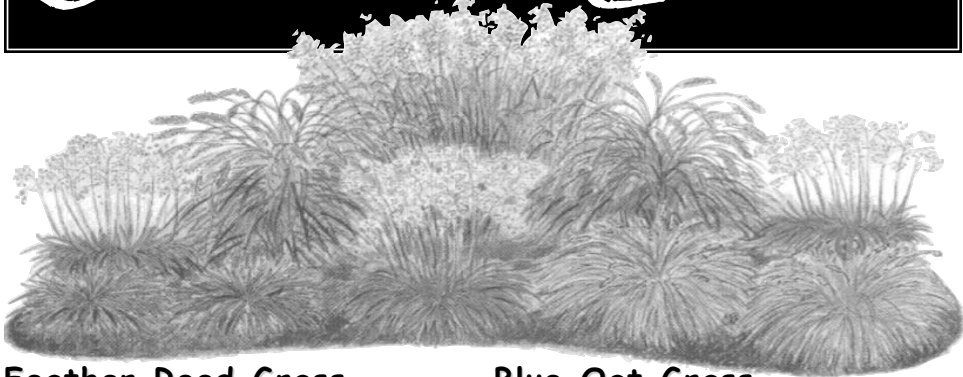


Ornamental Grasses



Feather Reed Grass

(*Calamagrostis arundinacea*)

'Karl Foerster' = Grows 4-5' tall.

The only grass voted "Perennial-of-the-Year" because it is outstanding - its slender clumps bloom in June & stay attractive through late winter. Zone 4.

Japanese Sedge (*Carex morrowii*)

'Evergold' = Grows 12-18" tall. Great for shade - a rarity among ornamental grasses. Bold yellow variegation makes this grass memorable! Zone 5.

'Ice Dance' = Grows 10-12" tall.

An outstanding grass for shade or partial shade. It is tough, colorful & all-purpose. Half inch wide, deep green blades are brightly bordered in pure white. Forms a dense, spreading, rounded clump that is neat & well kept. Zone 5.

Blue Fescue (*Festuca cinerea*)

'Elijah Blue' = Grows only 6-10"

tall. A small, mounding grass with excellent blue foliage. Blooms in June & July. Zone 4.

Hakonechloa (*Hakonechloa macra*)

'Aureola' = Grows 12-18" tall. Forms mounds of yellow & green foliage that resemble bamboo leaves.

Does best in partial shade. Zone 5.

Blue Oat Grass

(*Helictotrichon sempervirens*)

'Sapphire' = Grows 2-3' tall. Great

blue upright foliage. Brownish-blue flower spikes with tassels appear in early July & persist through the rest of the summer. Zone 4.

Japanese Blood Grass

(*Imperata cylindrica*)

'Red Baron' = Grows 12-18" tall.

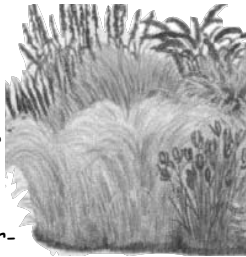
Aptly named, as the light green leaves are tipped with bright red. Prefers a sheltered location. Does not bloom. Zone 5

Maiden Grass

(*Miscanthus sinensis*)

'Adagio' = Grows

4' tall. A superior form of dwarf maiden grass with finely textured, narrow silver-gray foliage with flowers that emerge pink in August & turn white. Z 6. 'Cabaret' = Grows 5-6' tall. Wide, drooping foliage blades are attached to strong, upright growing stems & are a beautiful green on the edges with a wide, white center. Big brown-red plumes in late summer. Zone 6.



Maiden or Silver Grass

'Gold Bar' = Grows 3-4' tall. An incredible striped grass with color from the base to the top with tightly packed horizontal yellow striping. Lovely feathery plumes in early October. Zone 5.

'Gracillimus' = Grows 5-7' tall.

Forms a dense clump of gracefully arching narrow leaves. Coppery flowers appear in October. Does well in masses or as a specimen. Zone 5.

'Little Zebra' = Grows 3-4' tall.

Its dense, rounded form and narrow, arching, striking yellow-banded foliage make it a real winner. A low maintenance dream. Zone 5.

'Morning Light' = Grows 4-5' tall.

Narrow leaves are silver with a thin green center. A bright & stunning plant that matures to a fountain-like mound. Airy white flowers bloom in September-October. Zone 5.

'Purpurescens' = Grows 3-5' tall.

The deep green foliage suddenly turns all shades of red-orange-purple in early September. Tall flower spikes add to the show. A compact very upright form. Incredibly beautiful in mass. Zone 4.

'Strictus' (Porcupine) = Grows 6-7' tall. Unique variegation of horizontal

bands of yellow streak across the dark green foliage; creating an interesting effect. The vase shape form arcs gently at the top. Pinkish copper flowers bloom in September. Zone 5

Switch Grass

(*Panicum virgatum*)

'Heavy Metal' = Grows 4' tall. One of the best upright growers with wonderful blue foliage & yellow fall color.

Blooms July-September. Zone 4.

'Ruby Ribbons' = Grows 4-5' tall.

A real show-stopper. Metallic blue blades with fantastic red overtones. Z4 'Shenandoah' = Grows 3-4' tall. A showy narrow, upright, steely blue-green column of foliage. A dose of burgundy is added in late spring. Airy, small red flowers form in late August. Superb in winter with its swaying brown, dried foliage.

Fountain Grass

(*Pennisetum alopecuroides*)

'Hameln' = Grows 2' tall. A wonderful compact grower with slender, arching blades & graceful plumes of reddish flowers in August-October. Zone 5.

'Karley Rose' = Grows 2-3' tall.

Darker foliage & more upright look. Its deep pink flower plumes begin late July & keep on wowing the rest of the summer.

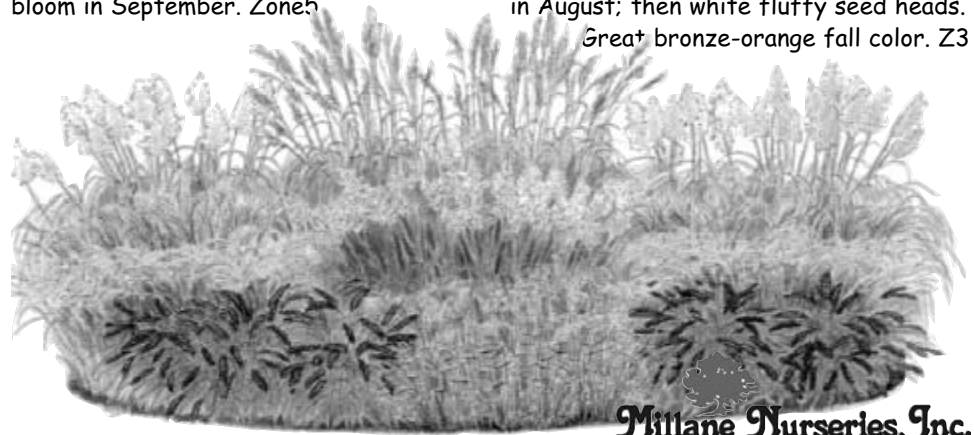
'Little Bunny' = Grows 12" tall. A cute, cuddly little edger for front of the border. Blooms in August-October.

Little Bluestem (*Schizachyrium*)

'The Blues' = Grows 2-3' tall.

Clumps of slender green-blue foliage with purplish-bronze seed stalks that emerge in August; then white fluffy seed heads.

Great bronze-orange fall color. Z3
